The Hope City Council met on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at 7:00 a.m. Present were Mayor Gary Ihry and council members Pat Brown, Tim Johnson, Jeff Juliuson and Mike Harvey. Also present were Karen Bergstrom, Loren Severson and Marvin S.

It was moved by Juliuson and seconded by Johnson to approve the minutes of the last regular meeting. Motion carried.

Loren Severson met to discuss taking some of his property out of the city limits. The auditor will contact the league of cities office.

The water rate increase from Dakota Water District was discussed.

It was moved by Brown and seconded by Johnson to approve housing incentives for James Platt and Eric Parkman for first time home owners and Pat Brendemuhl for remodeling. Motion carried.

It was moved by Brown and seconded by Johnson to approve a resolution declaring the vacation of that portion of Hubbard Ave. lying between Lots 1 through 8 in block 45 and lots 17 through 24 in block 46 OT, City of Hope and All of alley in block 45 lying between lots 1 through 8 on the north and lots 17 through 24 on the south in block 45 OT, City of Hope. It was moved by Harvey and seconded by Juliuson to approve building permits for Ihry, Lark properties and Hope Auto Glass. Motion carried.
